SUMMARY

The Child and Family Therapist of the Florida United Methodist Children's Home functions in a dual role of providing therapy to children and families and overseeing the cottage based on behavioral health and treatment planning programming for all residents on their assigned caseloads.

EDUCATION

- Masters Degree in Human Services or related field from a nationally accredited college or university
- Active LCSW, LMHC or LMFT is required
- Experience working with sexually reactive children preferred
- CAP preferred

QUALIFICATIONS

- Ability to organize and generate billable documentation in a timely manner
- Minimum one year experience working in a crisis environment (DJJ, In-Patient Psychiatric Treatment)
- Be willing and able to work with difficult youth and their families
- Be able to communicate (written and verbal) effectively with all staff
- Be computer literate and able to document case information electronically
- Have workable understanding of appropriate theory and methodology
- Must be able to work within the philosophy of services to children and families consistent with the ministry and goals of the Florida United Methodist Children's Home.
- Be familiar with DSM IV, ICD9-CM assessment and diagnosis
- Clean Driving Record
- Supervisory experience preferred
- Sensitivity to the service population's cultural and socioeconomic characteristics

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides individual, group, and family therapy to the residents and their families
- Have experience with Medicaid billing and documentation requirements preferred
- Does psychosocial assessment upon assignment of case
- Completes discharge summary at discharge
- Maintains case records
- Administers the Children's Functional Assessment Rating Scale (Florida Version) on all children in assigned caseload
- Attends psychiatric appointments, court hearings, judicial reviews, other legal meetings as required, and participates in Guardian ad Litem issues
- Provides oversight for behavioral health programming associated with the treatment plan for all children in assigned caseload
- Provides training to direct care staff in the particular components of the treatment plan and behavioral management components
- Serve as an on call supervisor for assigned cottage
- Ensures staff participation in team decisions
- Arranges home visits for the residents
- Works as the liaison between the Home and the family
- Coordinates community resources as needed by individual residents
- Facilitates treatment plan review/changeover meetings
- Is responsive when there is a need for crisis counseling

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervisory responsibilities ensure that the team members adhere to the treatment plan and behavioral management components.
