Without this program so many of our young adults would not be able to survive in society. I can't imagine not having a mother, father, grandparent, aunt or uncle to help support and encourage them through all of life's challenges. I'm so proud that all of our children will have a forever family here at the Children's Home.

The Residential Care program that is run by Vice President Mindy Chambers is the heartbeat of this agency. I have had the privilege and honor to get to know many of the House Parents. We are so blessed to have such dedicated, caring and loyal staff. I have watched their interaction with the children.

It makes me so proud for our children to have such wonderful house parents. Mindy, is incredible at what she does. She has multiple departments that she supervises.

As most of you know, Mark Nelson has been promoted to Vice President of Development. His expertise and passion for this ministry will allow him to lead the Development Department to new levels.

Thank you so much for giving me this wonderful opportunity to be part of such an amazing ministry.

We are fortunate enough to have several programs in place here at the Children's Home where kids can enjoy their summer.







All of our children on campus took part in our annual Summer Quest program. They took part in team building sports whether it be on the basketball court or in the swimming pool. They also traveled off campus with supervised short trips whether it was a quick trip to an area attraction, a stop at the local zoo or a picnic at an area park!

These may seem like insignificant activities however nothing could be further from the truth. Taking part in these activities helps our children gain self-confidence and build friendships, which helps them realize they are part of a loving and supportive family. Things that quite frankly, some children take for granted.

#### SUMMER CAMP



Another is the Warren W. Willis United Methodist Camp, located in Fruitland Park near Leesburg. Our high school residents were able to enjoy camp from June 24th-29th and our middle and elementary school residents were able to attend from July 1st-6th.

Many of those that attended camp learned about "The Ripple Effect". The Ripple Effect is when we place God in the center of our lives, and everything "ripples out" from our relationship with Jesus. Then, they are able to lead the lives of purpose that God intends for them to live.

Campers also participated in archery, canoeing, cooking, yoga, swimming, frisbee, and more. In addition, they experienced life-changing worship, Bible study and prayer time each day. Many of our residents recommitted their lives to Christ, and several committed their lives to Christ for the first time.

One resident says that camp helped her to "See that God needs to be in the center of everything." She also committed to "Put off worldly things and bad influences", so that she could strive to live for Christ in all that she does.

## SUMMER TALENT SHOW


#### 1 PETER 4:10-11

## **OPEN HEARTS FAMILY SERVICES**

## Rewards of Fostering



While many of you know about what we do here at the Children's Home, you may not know about our Open Hearts Family Services program which also helps children in need.

Open Hearts Family Services is a program where foster parents are recruited to work with the Children's Home staff to provide a nurturing, faith based, and family oriented environment.

The program is vital since the Department of Children and Families is currently placing many of the children removed from their homes with foster parents, not in a residential setting. With our Open Hearts program, we are able to help those children, just as much as those that reside with us here on our Central Florida campus.

So what are the rewards? For the most part they are non-monetary, even though foster parents do receive a stipend from the state to help offset costs involved with fostering.

Here are a few of the more significant rewards:

- · Providing for a child's physical, emotional and mental needs
- · Helping a child learn to trust an adult and feel safe
- Offering a child a better life (maybe even saving that child's life)
- · Helping a child learn how to care for and help others
- Experiencing your own personal growth as you use your strength, courage and skills to help transform a life
- Witnessing (and sometimes helping) biological parents "change their ways" for the sake of their child. If the family can't make it, be the stabilizer who helps the child transition into a new phase of his/her life.

What greater reward could there be than giving a new life to a child; especially to a child who has been hurt or damaged by mistakes of adults who were supposed to be the child's love and support system? To be able to help a child learn to trust and love again is quite a reward in itself.

If you're questioning whether you are ready to become a foster parent, we encourage you to pray and ask God for guidance. If you're interested in learning more about Open Hearts and how we can help, please contact any of those listed below.

During their time at camp, the children were able to enjoy themselves whether it was just by sitting on the dock and dipping their toes in the water, or by paddling a canoe across the lake with their family!

They were also able to take part in entertaining Bible lessons, family crafts, worship, and even a talent show! Some of the children sang songs while others performed in drama skits with their foster parents.

One of our foster parents shared this: "Family Camp was great. The time was family-oriented, based on God's love for all of us. It was a couple of great days to be together as a family for fun and a great experience to learn about God in our daily life."

One of the children wrote this: "I had a good time canoeing. I liked the food, hiking, singing, games, meet and greet, and meeting new families. I love God...thank you."

Summer camp was important not only because it allowed foster children to meet other kids who came from similar backgrounds, but because it also provided them with an environment of fun and safety, allowing them for a short time to set aside their trauma and experience the joy of being a kid.


Without the support we received from donors, our families would not have been able to attend the camp!


Ryan's last day at the Children's Home was June 20th. Staff and residents gathered in the chapel to say good bye.

This summer we celebrated the accomplishments of our children during the last portion of the previous school year during an awards ceremony held in our campus chapel. Many young men and women were recognized and rewarded for good conduct, while others received an award for improving their grade point average. Some were even rewarded for both! The awards were handed out by our Vice President of Residential Care, Mindy Chambers. It was an evening that most of them will probably never forget!

Some of the quieter children were shy as they went up to accept their awards; however, many raised their fists in joy as they walked up front to receive their award and had no desire to hide their pride! The best thing about the evening was how all the children supported one another. You could truly feel God's presence surrounding them all.

Our education program, located in the Worrell Memorial Education Center, provides numerous resources including a library, computers, resource materials, tutoring rooms and more to help enhance what each boy and girl receives in school every day. The following is a look at some of the awards for the second half of the school year:

- 10 residents made the Honor Roll
- 23 residents increased their GPA
- 48 residents received all Good Conduct Marks on their report cards
- 4 seniors graduated
- 2 residents were recognized for highest GPA at 3.62 and 3.46

"I saw both boys perform at the Christmas show last year and immediately thought they both were fantastic on stage" Mary says. "When an acquaintance who worked at 102 Jamz stated two of the Disc Jockeys were interested in mentoring youth, I knew they had to meet RJ and Chris."

Mary arranged for both boys to visit the Orlando radio station where they met Disc Jockey Young Smitchell. After receiving a tour of the station, the boys also met Disc Jockey D-Strong who hosts his own show during the afternoons. Strong also Disc Jockeys for the Orlando Magic and singer Ciara.

"To prepare for the job shadow, I used the Junior Achievement job shadow curriculum which covers job skills" Mary says. "The boys were given a home work assignment to write down questions to ask. During the experience I was very impressed with RJ and Chris to see them using these success skills when interacting with the Disc Jockeys. Both asked thoughtful questions and really paid attention to what they were observing and learning."

Both boys were shown how to use the equipment and how to edit commercials. They were then allowed to record and edit two commercial spots and keep copies!

While Strong was on-air, both boys were also able to give a "shout out" to their schools and help with a music countdown.

Afterwards, Chris and RJ were able to show off their talents. Chris performed some of his dance moves and RJ was able to do a rap for the Disc Jockeys.

"Both boys said it was the best day of their lives" Mary says. "To see these two teenagers editing commercials and speaking on the radio filled my heart with joy, this is why I love my job."

It's that time of year again...we are already making preparations for the upcoming Christmas season. It's a chance to remind our children about the birth of Jesus and what the day is truly about. It is also a chance to provide our children with the traditional Christmas joy that many of them may have never experienced.

As the new President, I'm always looking for ways to effectively and efficiently steward the generosity of our churches, businesses and individual donors. With that said, I would like you to assess our new plan for requesting and receiving Christmas gifts that you so faithfully provide our residents. This year, we would like you to prayerfully make donations of gift cards in order to present to our residents in care.

This is going to be an incredibly exciting Christmas for our children on campus, because we are listening to their requests and reaching out to our United Methodist family to help us surprise our children. Our children would like gift cards this year so that they can go shopping and get the specific gift they would like to have. As you know, our children don't have the money to shop like most young people, so this will be a new and exciting time for them during this special holiday season.

We are asking that you please purchase gift cards in any increments of \$5, \$10, \$20, \$25 and \$50 to stores like Wal-Mart, Target, and Best Buy. Our goal is to be able to give every child in our care \$150.00 in gift cards. If this happens, just think how excited a child will be, knowing that \$150.00 can be spent on something special they want as opposed to personal items to which their \$30 monthly allowance is used for during the year.

Here is a wonderful example of how this could work:

Every year in July, the United Methodist Men host a Christmas in July dinner, and guests bring toys to put under the Christmas tree. This year, they shifted focus on our need for financial gifts, giving us more flexibility. Even though, they still had a few gifts placed under the Tree, guests gave cash donations allowing them to raise over \$1,200 to purchase gift cards for our youth. Furthermore, now through early December, they will have an Angel Tree available with wishes from our kids hanging from the branches, but instead of asking for unwrapped gifts in response to our children's wishes, they will attach envelopes to the angels and ask for gift cards.

All in all, I'm looking to take care of you, our gracious donors, along with the needs of our ever-changing community living in our care.

Again, I thank you for your love and prayers that cover our children and this Ministry.


