SUMMARY

The Warehouse Coordinator is responsible for receiving, sorting, pricing, and preparing donated items for display in the thrift store. This position is a one of three key holders and is a back-up to management.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE

High School Diploma or GED equivalent—retail/resale experience preferred

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have a valid Florida Driver License
- Must be physically fit. This job involves, stretching, walking and lifting boxes, bins and bags up to 75 pounds
- Must have good organizational skills
- Must have good communications skills with volunteers, donors, staff, and customers
- Ability to sort items based on established standards
- Ability to determine condition of items and fairly price items based on established standards
- Ability to work independently
- Must be able to efficiently coordinate volunteers
- Retail experience is helpful
- Have sensitivity to the service population's cultural and socioeconomic characteristics

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Receive, sort, price, and display donated items
- Coordinate volunteers in the resale shop and warehouse ensuring compliance with established policies and procedures, processes, and displays
- Maintain hanging and shelving displays and fixtures in the show room
- Ensures displays are attractive, neat, and orderly—including rotating and re-stocking store merchandise in order to ensure quick turnover
- Determine fair pricing of items based on condition and whether items are collectible/antique
- Maintains orderliness and cleanliness of the warehouse area and public bathrooms
- Prepare items for pickup by salvage company
- Coordinate items for dumping
- Assists the Field Representatives in scheduling deliveries and pick-ups
- Assists Management in backing up Customer Service Representatives
- Covers opening or closing responsibilities of store to cover management days off

This position has supervisory responsibilities in regards to coordinating volunteers.
