Providing supportive and structured residential care, case management services, and life skills training for young adults exiting foster care and other young adults and single mothers

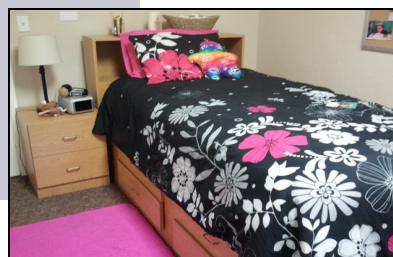
Qualifications

- For young adults, ages 18–26 years old.
- Young adults with a need and desire for support, structure, accountability, and life skills training.
- Able to maintain daily self-care habits for good physical, mental, and spiritual health.
- Able to uphold a 40 hour a week schedule of a combination of school, studies and / or employment.
- Willing to attend case management meetings, community meetings, life skills workshops and outreaches.
- Willing to be financially accountable with income and expenses and to meet monthly savings goals.
- Able to pay the monthly extended foster care board rate or an income-based board rate.
- No history of extreme violent or sexual criminal offenses and no current drug use.
- Willing to pro-actively set and reach goals for a successful program exit and long-term self-sufficiency.

To apply for residency, call for a phone interview. Eligible young adults are asked to send in personal records and to complete an application. After a personal interview and acceptance a move-in date is scheduled. Tours and visits are welcome!
