Rather than trying to reach out to 600+ churches every time we approach a new Fifth Sunday, our plan is to use whatever order you give us now for your future Fifth Sunday orders. Whenever things change and you would like to adjust your order, please just send us an email or give us a call and we will be happy to make the adjustment then.

We want these supplies to be beneficial to your church's needs, so there are options for you to customize the order. First off, we offer electronic versions of our inserts and posters on our website at <a href="https://www.fumch.org/making-a-difference/church-relations/">https://www.fumch.org/making-a-difference/church-relations/</a>. If you would like to switch to electronic supplies in lieu of receiving the printed ones, please let us know so that we can cancel your print order.

If you decide, instead, that printed supplies are beneficial for you, we want to get an accurate count of how many your congregation currently needs. Even if you responded to our request for order changes several months back, we need a response again to make sure our records stay accurate. Please let us know if you have any questions.
