- Robert really struggled with focus and staying on task. After a year with us working with his therapist, the psychiatrist, and the behavior analyst, he performed in the Day on Campus production of the Wizard of Oz.
- This was a big deal for Robert because it meant sitting through long rehearsals and staying on task and knowing his cues throughout the show. We are so proud of Robert and his progress!
